



Ultimate Texas Hold'em™ features heads-up play against the Dealer and an optional Bonus Bet. This game gives you several advantages:

- The earlier you bet, the more you can bet
- You don't have to fold until you see all the community cards
- The Trips bonus pays odds if your final 5 card hand is a three - of - a - kind or better

GETTING STARTED

Make equal bets in the Ante and Blind circles. You may also make the optional Trips bonus bet. You will then receive 2 cards.

BET BIG... OR SMALL... OR NOT AT ALL

When you get your two hole cards, you can either check or bet 3x - 4x your Ante. The Dealer then reveals the 3 card flop. If you haven't already made a Play bet, you have a choice: check or bet 2x your Ante. The Dealer then reveals the final 2 Community Cards. If you haven't already made a Play bet, you have a choice: fold or bet 1x your Ante.

WINNING & LOSING

The Dealer then reveals his 2 hole cards and announces his hand. If your hand beats the Dealer's, your Play and Ante bets win even money. If the Dealer's hand beats yours, your Play, Ante and Blind Wagers lose. If you tie, those bets Push. The Blind pays if your winning hand is at least a Straight (see layout for odds). If you beat the Dealer with less than a Straight, it Pushes.

DEALER QUALIFYING

The Dealer needs a pair to qualify. When the Dealer doesn't qualify, he returns your Ante. All other bets receive action.

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Must be at least 19 years of age to enter the casino.

- 2 cards to each Player (used by that Player only)
- 2 cards to the Dealer (used by Dealer only)
- 5 Community Cards face up on the table (to be used by both Player and Dealer, along with their 2 card hands)

ANTE	Each Player makes an ANTE Wager to receive 2 cards
BONUS	Players also have the option to place a BONUS JACKPOT Wager
2 Cards FLOP OR FOLD	A 2 card hand is dealt to each Player and the Dealer Players wishing to continue to play must wager twice the amount of the Ante; Players not wishing to continue may hand-in their 2 cards and forfeit the Ante Wager
3 Cards TURN	3 Community Cards are now placed "face-up" on the table Players now have the option to not bet, or bet equal to the ANTE
1 Card RIVER	A 4th Community Card is turned "face-up" on the table Players now have the option to not bet, or bet equal to the Ante
1 Card	A 5th Community Card is turned "face-up" on the table

Each Player uses his/her 2 card hand, along with 3, 4 or all of the 5 Community Cards, to make the best "Poker Hand!"

Any two cards can win!

- No Player to Player competition
- Each Player plays against the Dealer
- Best Poker-Ranking hand wins
- Optional side-bet wager plays against a posted payable (not the Dealer's hand)
- When a Player wins, the Player retains his/her Ante and is paid even money on the total of the FLOP + TURN + RIVER Wagers
- When a Player's winning hand is a "Flush" or greater, they are paid in additional amount equal to his/her Ante
- All poker-ranked hands of equal value between Player and Dealer will be considered a "Tie" or "Push"
- Bonus Jackpot Wagers are paid no matter who wins the hand (Players or Dealer)
